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Accreditation Status


- ACEN: “Good Cause” extension granted through Fall 2022

Admissions - Goal: Increase cohort profile


- Increased cohort UG science and math GPA

Short-Term Strategies

- Addition of test taking training
- 3-Day NCLEX preparation workshops
- 10-week NCLEX Readiness training with ATI personal coach for each student
- Ongoing intrusive advisement and remediation for score under 76%
- End-of-semester NCLEX bootcamps and post-graduation Learning Community for NCLEX readiness

- Curriculum re-mapping to the new Essentials
- New NCLEX Next Gen Writing Workshops
- QSEN integration workshop by National QSEN Director

- Fully compliant with the American Bar Association Standards


Admissions - Goal: Increase cohort profile

- Reduced size of incoming cohorts
- Increased median undergraduate GPA
- Increased median LSAT

Curriculum and Assessment

- Revamped curriculum implemented Fall 2020
- Adopted measure targeted at vulnerable students that requires robust advising and additional coursework as a condition of graduation
- Revamping academic support program to frontload resources so that students hone their analytical skills at the beginning of the program rather than trying to remediate deficiencies during the third year and bar prep
