BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rising student debt levels have made national headlines in the last few years; however, the Florida story is different. Nationally, other colleges and universities have seen a 17% increase in tuition since 2014-15. Through investments made in higher education by the Governor and legislature, Florida has held tuition and fees flat since 2014-2015, while financial aid has increased to historic highs. These efforts have resulted in the average cost for a bachelor's degree to be less than \$2,000 in the State University System. In 2020-21, 75% of the System's resident undergraduates did not report any loans, up from 58% in 2014-15.
