# Highlights





#### Lower costs to students

49% reduction in 2020-21; Overall System lower cost on PBF 3



#### More degrees in needed fields

**11%** increase in degrees awarded in **Programs of Strategic Emphasis** 



#### **Increase in 4-yr graduation rates**


















### KPI 7. Pell Recipient Four-Year Graduation Rate Full-time FTIC




# FTIC Non-Pell & Pell Graduation Rates







- **FCS AA transfer enrollment: -5%** (-3,535 students)
- Other undergraduates: -2% (-986 students)

Postbaccalaureates: -3% (-166 students)

- Plans for undergraduate enrollments at 8 of 12 institutions are to grow marginally or not at all from fall 2021 to fall 2022
- **5 institutions plan to grow their enrollment** this fall
