Action

- Require students to complete profiles & create & maintain resumes in Handshake or Symplicity
- Centralize internship reporting
- Develop best practices for an institution-wide internship advisory council
- Ensure continuous feedback regarding internships between employers, universities & students

What is an internship?





Institutions may use a national definition for internships, or may include more experiential learning experiences as internships



An internship is a form of experiential learning that integrates knowledge & theory learned in the classroom with practical application & skills development in a professional setting.








Institutions use multiple facilitators to secure internships

Not-for-credit internships





- Many institutions track via graduating senior student surveys
