SUBJECT: Public Notice of Approval of Amendment to Board of Governors Regulation 8.007, Articulation

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consider approval of the amendment to Board of Governors Regulation 8.007, Articulation.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 8.007 provides guidance on numerous articulation issues outlined in, among others, sections 1007.23 and 1007.25, Florida Statutes. The regulation ensures consistency among universities and the Florida College System, allowing students to proceed toward their educational objectives as rapidly as their circumstances permit.

The proposed amendments align the regulation with two recent statutory changes. First, the 2021 Legislature amended section 1007.25, Florida Statutes, directing students entering an associate in science program in the 2022-2023 academic year to complete one general education core course in each subject area as part of the general education requirements. Second, the 2022 Legislature amended section 1007.24, Florida Statutes, requiring institutions to apply transfer credit towards general education requirements before applying the credits towards electives.

The Board of Governors approved the Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 6.006, Acceleration Mechanisms, at its June 30, 2022, meeting. Following approval of the public notice of intent, no public comments were received, and the regulation as amended is ready for final approval.
