BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board Regulation 2.002 requires the Board of Governors to annually submit a State University System summary to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. At its June 2022 meeting, the Strategic Planning Committee considered approval of 2022 accountability plans. In addition, the committee considered the annual university preeminence status updates for Florida State University, the University of Florida, and the University of South Florida and the emerging preeminence updates for Florida International University and the University of Central Florida.

Based on the data and information provided in the institutional accountability plans, Board staff analyzed system-level data and trends for key performance indicators. The System Accountability Plan also includes system information on specialized accreditation, student learning outcomes, institutes and centers, and academic program actions.

If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee, the 2022 System Accountability Plan will be forwarded to the full Board for consideration.
