Do you accept industry certification as meeting mathematics or natural science core requirements?

- No. While industry certifications will certainly add to a student's portfolio, it does not take the place of a designated mathematics or natural science core course as required within our college preparatory expectations.
- Students must still take a minimum of 4 math courses and 3 natural science (2 or more with labs).

Do you accept a computer science course as meeting math or natural science core?

 No. Students must take 4 math courses of Algebra I level or higher and at least 3 natural science courses, including at least 2 with laboratory experiences.

Do you have other ways for students to be admitted to your institution?

- Yes. Students may want to consider one of the 81 2+2 Enhancement Programs established with Florida College System institutions.
- Talk to the admission director for the institution of interest about programs specifically tied to that institution.

What are the types of Florida residency waivers

- DACA/Non-Resident who attends FL HS for at least three years and graduates from FL HS; must complete waiver forms at enrolling institution
- Grandparent Waiver
 - Be admitted as FTIC, undergraduate, degree-seeking
 - Have a grandparent living in FL defined by Statute 1009.21(1)
 - Earn HS diploma comparable to FL standard high school diploma or equivalent, or completes home education program
 - Has an SAT score no lower than 89th percentile or ACT in concordance
 - Must submit required documentation to institution; these are first-comefirst-served and not guaranteed
