Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 3.006, Accreditation.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Senate Bill 7044 from the 2022 Legislative Session established section 1008.47, Florida Statutes. The law requires each institution to establish and maintain institutional accreditation with an agency or association recognized by the database created and maintained by the United States Department of Education.

The proposed amendment to the Board regulation will align regulatory language with the new statutory requirement. If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee and the Board of Governors, the amended regulation will be available for public comment for thirty days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Dr. Christy England, Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, will provide an overview of the amendment to the regulation.
