-1.5% decline**

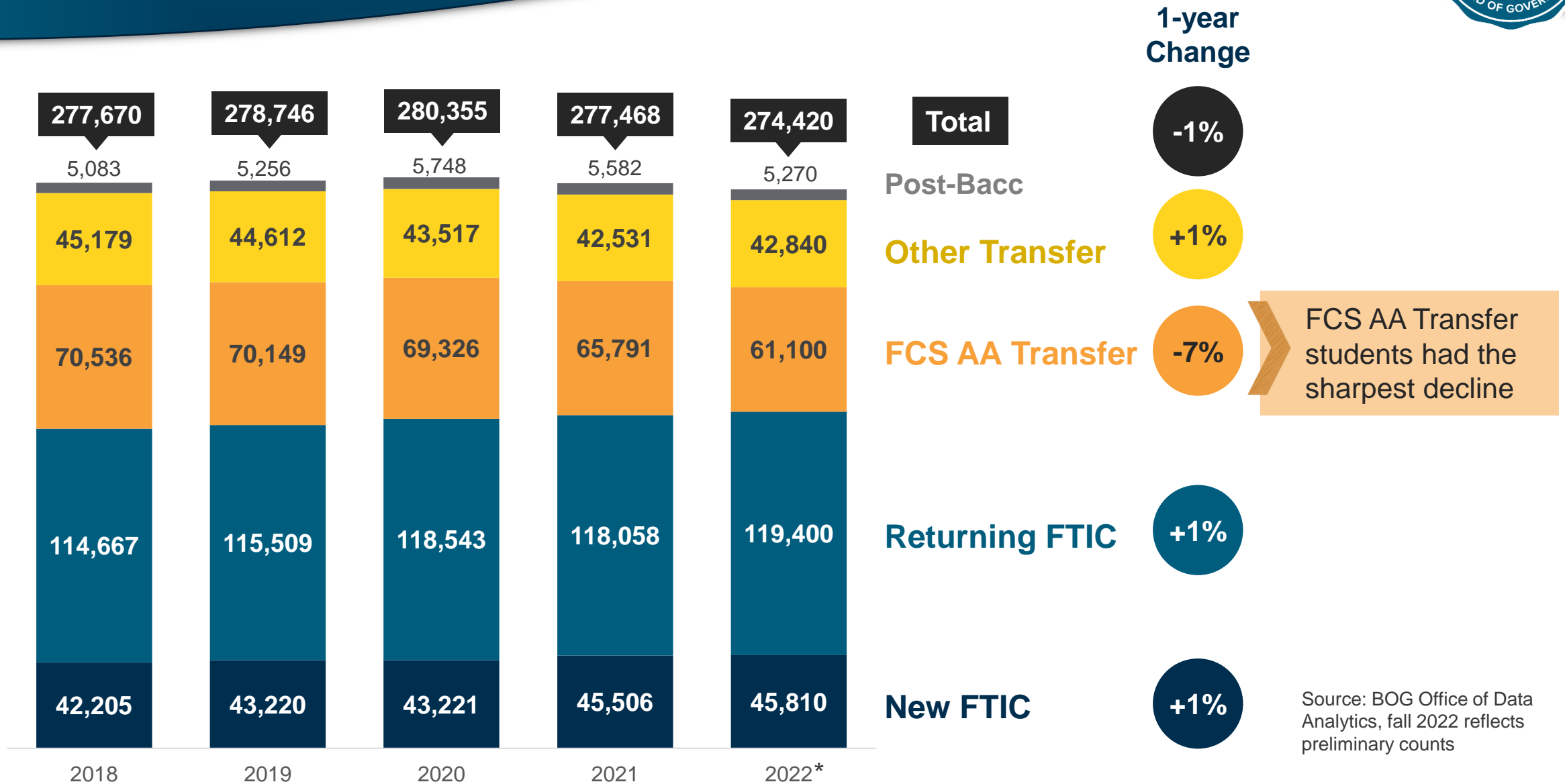


**National:

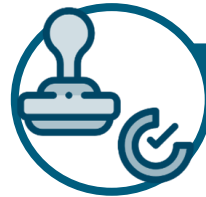
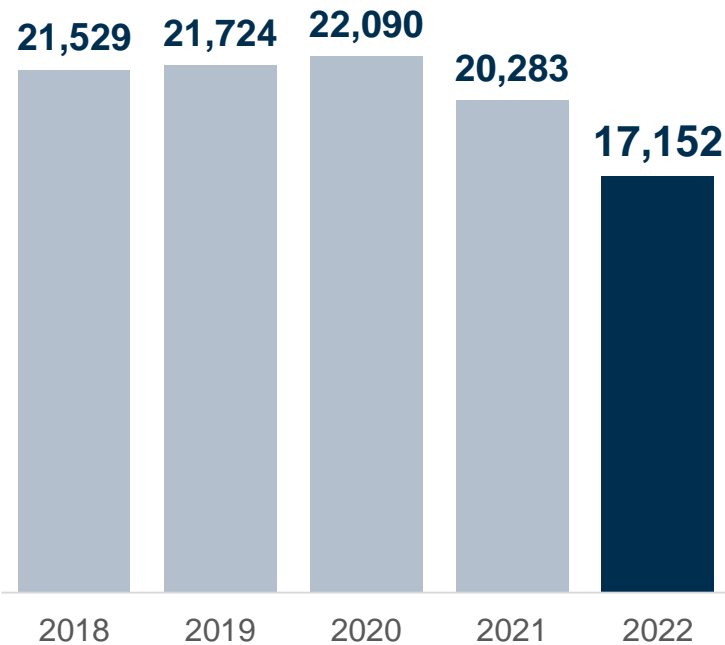
System Enrollment Trends: FCS AA Transfer Admissions



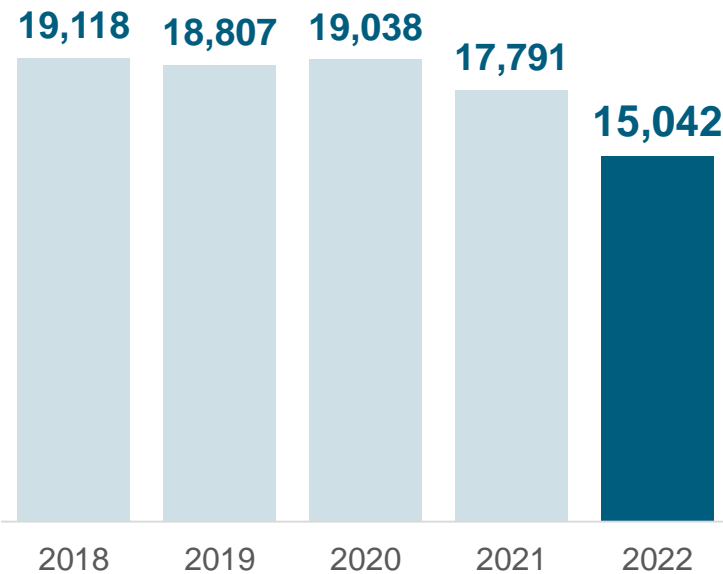
Despite fewer applicants, the System maintained about the same admit rate of 88%, & the percent of admitted students who enrolled remained the same at 77%



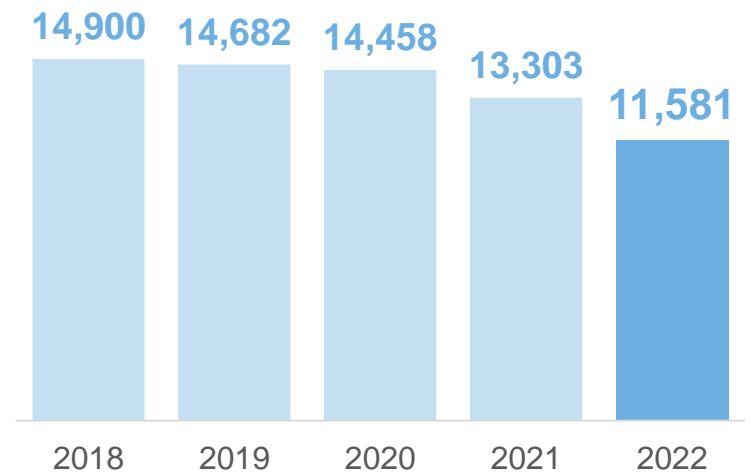

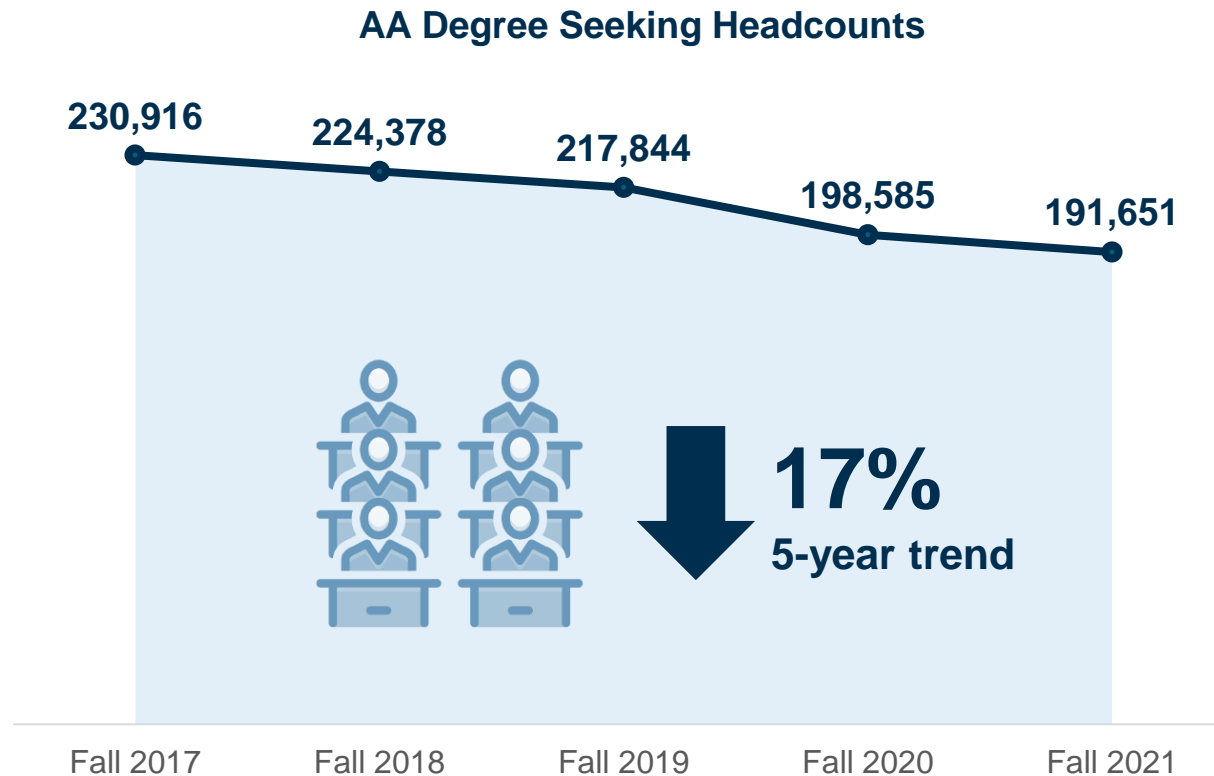

AA Degree Enrollment at FCS down each of last five years



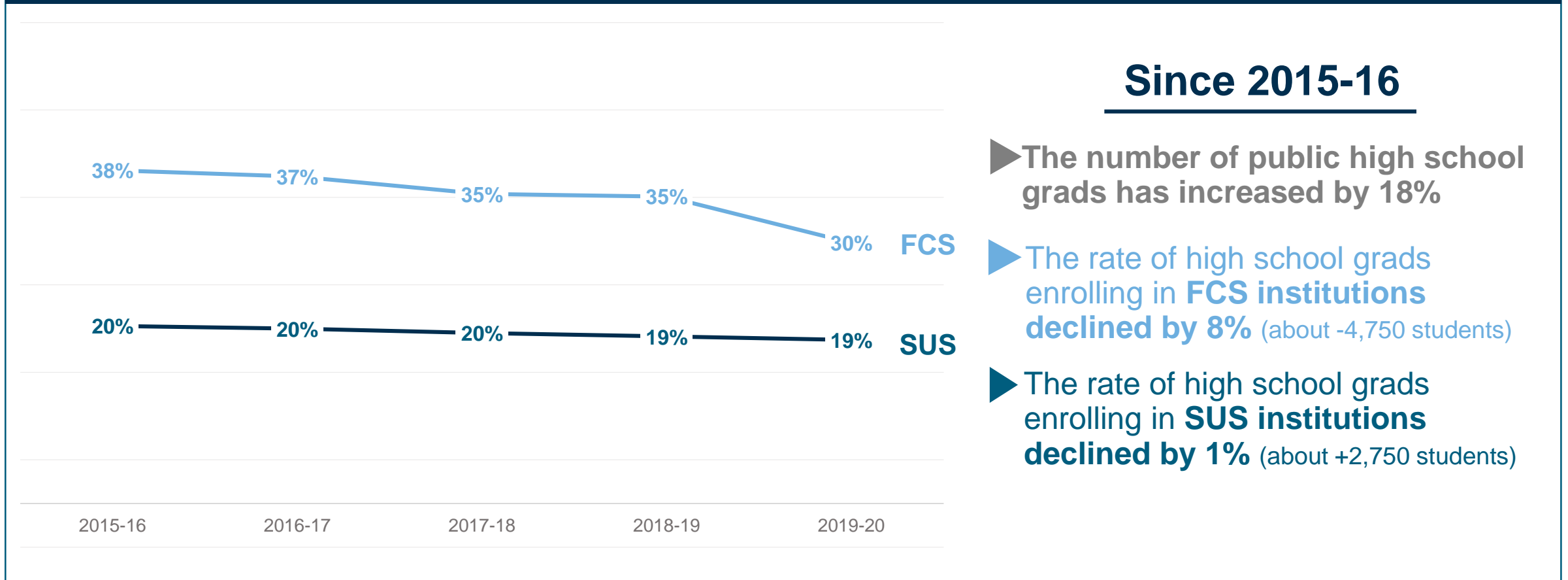
Preliminary data for fall 2022 beginning of term suggest AA enrollment in the Florida College System is increasing to pre-pandemic figures

Enrolled in a postsecondary institution in following Fall term by institution type

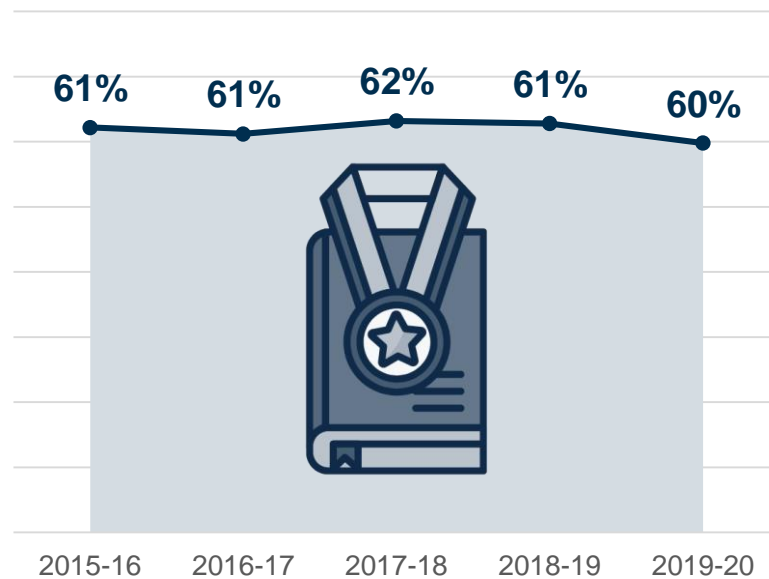

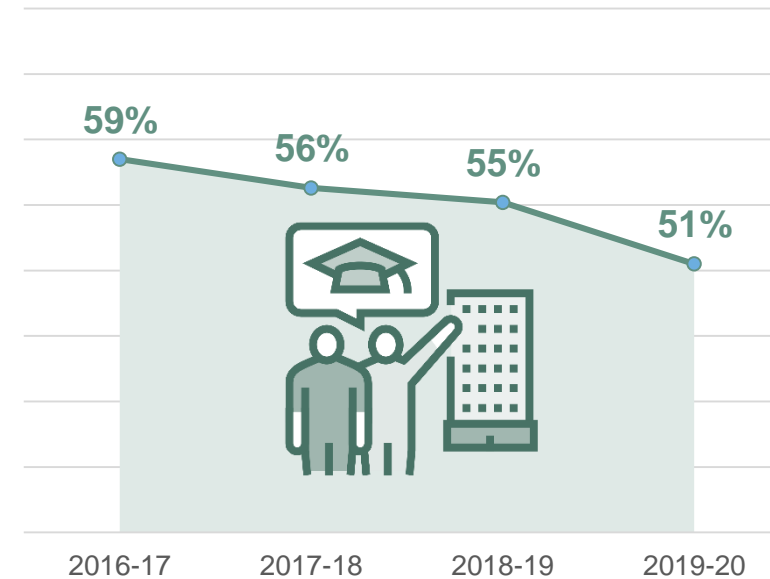


Florida Public High School to College Pipeline

Long-Term Projections



While high school graduates are predicted to decline nationwide, Florida high school graduates are expected to grow



Between 2024-25 & 2036-37, Florida graduates are projected to **increase by 6%** (14,860 students)



During that time U.S. graduates are projected to **decrease by 10%** (410,880 students)
