New Nursing Funding in 2022-23





The Legislature created two new programs designed to expand nursing education in Florida in 2022-23

\$40 M

PIPELINE Fund created to reward performance & excellence among public postsecondary nursing education programs

\$6 M

LINE Fund created to incentivize collaboration between nursing education programs & healthcare partners by providing a dollar-for-dollar match for contributions from healthcare partners





The number of nursing graduates has increased by 33% over the past 10 years






Licensure Passage Rates

Florida graduates exceed the national average of 86%





Nursing Graduate Employment Rates & Wages






System graduates are employed at high rates and earn above average wages


