The Programs of Strategic Emphasis help align State University System degree production with Florida's economic & workforce needs













Percent of Degrees Awarded in Programs of Strategic Emphasis

- Nearly 2/3 of graduate degrees awarded in the System







Initial discussion with Board

February - August 2023

Complete initial analyses required to recommend updates in all categories

September 2023

Board considers initial recommendations

November 2023

Board votes on final recommendations

House Bill 1507, the Reimagining Education & Career Help (REACH) Act, established the Credential Review Committee to identify credentials & degrees of value
