



FAMU had the greatest one-year percentage increase in undergraduate students taking at least one online course: From 45% in 2018-19 to 55% in 2019-2020.



FAMU was one of two institutions that had the greatest one-year percentage increase in online undergraduate credit hours: FAMU increased from 10% in 2018-19 to 14% in 2019-20.

In 1891, the college was moved from its original location west of town to its present location which was once the site of "Highwood," Territorial Governor W.P. Duval's slave plantation The site is one of the highest hills in Tallahassee. The school was known as Florida A&M College from 1909 until 1053 it attained university state
