Regulation 8.002 Self-Supporting & Market Tuition Rate Program & Course Offerings



Purpose

Clarifies requirements for market tuition rate programs



Impetus for Action

- Align with Florida Statutes & technical updates



Proposed Amendment

- Clarifies that universities may submit proposals for market tuition rates for graduate-level courses offered online or through the university's continuing education program
- Revises the minimum required information that must be included in a market tuition rate program proposal



Impact on Institutions

- Institutions must provide required information on program proposals for market tuition rate

Regulation 8.015

Academic Program Review



Purpose

Repeals regulation that requires universities to submit academic program reviews to the Board office



Impetus for Action

- Eliminate institution reporting requirements not required in Florida Statutes



Proposed Repeal of Regulation

- Provides flexibility for institutions to conduct program reviews tailored to specific needs & goals of institutions & programs



Impact on Institutions

- Reduces reporting requirements for institutions

Regulation 6.022

Intercollegiate Athletes



Purpose

Provides greater flexibility intercollegiate athletes to earn compensation from their name, image, & likeness



Impetus for Action

- Align with legislative change from the 2023 February Special Session



Proposed Regulation

- Removes prior requirements for student-athletes to use their name, image, & likeness
- Adds entrepreneurship as a required course topic
- Protects universities from liability



Impact on Institutions

- Universities must offer entrepreneurship workshops to student athletes as required in statute
