NOTICE OF PROPOSED REPEALED REGULATION**

DATE: June 23, 2023

REGULATION NUMBER AND TITLE: 6.012, Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students.

SUMMARY: Board of Governors Regulation 6.012, Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students, grants public secondary school students enrolled in articulated acceleration programs access to electronic library resources funded by the Florida Center for Library Automation.

Board staff propose repealing Regulation 6.012 and incorporating the content into Regulation 6.006, Acceleration Mechanisms, to better organize and streamline Board regulations by merging all accelerated mechanism requirements into a single regulation.
