SUBJECT: Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 6.005, Admission of Associate in Arts High School Students

PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 6.005, Admission of Associate in Arts High School Students.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 6.005, Admission of Associate in Arts High School Students, outlines requirements for undergraduate admission for first-time-in-college students entering the university with an A.A. degree.

The 2023 Florida Legislature passed House Bill 1537, which was signed into law on May 9, 2023. The bill revised section 1008.22, Florida Statutes, to authorize school districts to administer the Classic Learning Test (CLT) in addition to the SAT and ACT. In addition, the bill revised section 1009.531, Florida Statutes, to allow students to be eligible for the Bright Futures Scholarship Program based on CLT scores that concord to equivalent SAT or ACT scores.

Board staff propose amending Regulation 6.005 to meet the needs of students that may take the CLT as authorized by the above statutes. The proposed amendment adds the CLT as an acceptable test for high school students with A.A. degrees who choose to submit test scores.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the amended regulation will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Dr. Christy England, Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, will provide an overview of the proposed amendment to the regulation.
