SUBJECT: Florida International University – Amendment of Fixed Capital Outlay Budget

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve the amendment to Florida International University's FY22-23 Fixed Capital Outlay Budget, as described.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution; Sections 1011.45 and 1013.31, Florida Statutes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On November 9, 2022, the Board approved Florida International University's (FIU) Fixed Capital Outlay Budget for FY2022-23, attached for reference.

One of the projects, *Engineering Building Phase I*, was approved with an estimated total project cost of \$64.7M, which has since increased by \$9.2M (14%) to approximately \$73.9M due to labor/material cost escalation as well as design progression from advanced schematics to full construction documents. FIU anticipates funding the increase from unrestricted treasury auxiliary, as reflected in the chart below.

For projects that received State appropriation, Board Regulation 14.003 requires that project budget increases over \$5 million must be approved by the Board of Trustees

and Board of Governors. The FIU Board of Trustees (BOT) approved the amended FCO Budget on February 23, 2023.

The project's current design includes 'shell' space that will be built out at a later date at additional cost. At this early juncture, those costs are undetermined, but amendments will be brought back before the BOT and Board, as necessary pursuant to Regulation 14.003.
