SUBJECT: Withdrawal of Amendment to Board of Governors Regulation 3.0075, Security of Data and Related Information Technology Resources

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consider approval to withdraw the proposed amendment to Board of Governors Regulation 3.0075, Security of Data and Related Information Technology Resources.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 3.0075, Security of Data and Related Information Technology Resources, outlines the requirements for information security for the State University System.

At the March 28, 2023 meeting, the committee approved a version of the amended regulation and issued an emergency regulation implementing the amended regulation.

Subsequently, Senate Bill 258 was introduced, passed, and signed into law that requires the Department of Management Services to implement a restricted technology security process statewide. This bill goes into effect July 1, 2023. The passage of SB 258 negates the need for the proposed amendment.

Pursuant to Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure, after the 14-day public comment period, the Board may "withdraw or modify the regulation." Board staff suggests withdrawing the proposed amendment to Regulation 3.0075 and allowing the emergency regulation to expire at the end of the 90-day period on June 26, 2023.

Mr. Gene Kovacs, Chief Information Officer, will provide an update on the Department of Managed Services' implementation of SB 258.
