Changes to Section 1009.26, Florida Statutes

Senate Bill 266 makes the following changes to the Programs of Strategic Emphasis Tuition Waiver

Adds Eligible Programs	Adds 2 state-approved teacher preparation programs		
	 Must be identified by the Board 		

Addresses Removed Programs Clarifies that if a program is removed from the approved list after a student enrolls, they will **continue to receive the waiver** until they do one of the following

- o Graduate
- Exceed the number of allowable credit hours
- Withdraw from an eligible program



Estimated Fiscal Impact – Fall 2023






Estimated Fall 2023 waiver costs range from
