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Highlights





Higher earnings for graduates

8.3% increase in **median wages** for bachelor's graduates

- UNF, FAMU, & FGCU had the biggest 1-year improvement
- Median wages for graduates increased at all institutions last year, ranging from \$34,900 to \$54,800 (PBF 2)
- With lower costs & higher starting wages, Florida graduates are seeing a greater return-on-investment from their SUS degree

All institutions improved performance over the last 5 years

- 5 institutions (FIU, UNF, FAU, UWF, FGCU) improved by more than 10 percentage pts the last 5 years
- UF & FSU exceeded the Board's goal of 65%
- 7 met or exceeded their own goal
- More students are graduating on-time, ready to support Florida's workforce




Most institutions did not see significant change in their enrollment of Pell students






Fall 2021 to Fall 2022 Enrollments






