**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Board Regulation 8.004, Academic Program Coordination, requires that the Board of Governors office coordinate with the Council of Academic Vice Presidents (CAVP) and the Council of Academic Vice Presidents Academic Coordination Group (CAVP ACG) to conduct a comprehensive review of all academic programs offerings at least once every three years. This comprehensive review identifies degree programs that fall below a five-year threshold for degrees granted and is effective in addressing program efficiencies.

Since the CAVP ACG's inception, four extensive reviews of system-wide academic programs have been conducted. These reviews have been completed in 2011, 2015, 2019, and 2023. The most recent review of existing programs identified 145 programs in the System with degrees awarded below the threshold between academic years 2016-2017 and 2020-2021. As part of this review process, CAVP ACG reports a course of action identified for improving program productivity and increasing degrees awarded.

Dr. Christy England, Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, will present the 2023 degree productivity analysis results.
