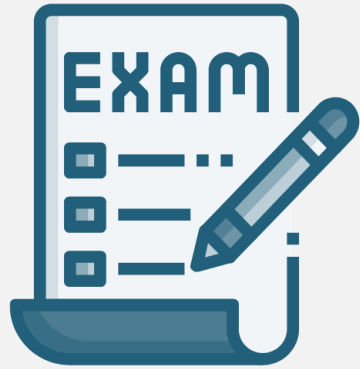

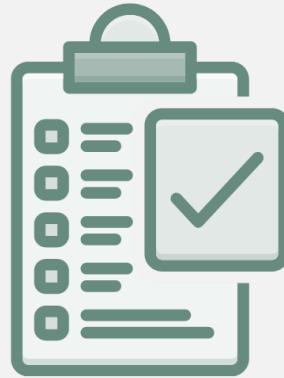

Purpose of the Credit-by-Exam & Work Experience Equivalencies



Allows students to receive postsecondary credit for

performance on national exams & prior military & law enforcement experience



Set minimum course recommendations for exam scores & prior experience to be used across education systems



Ensure smooth articulation & reduce unnecessary additional course requirements

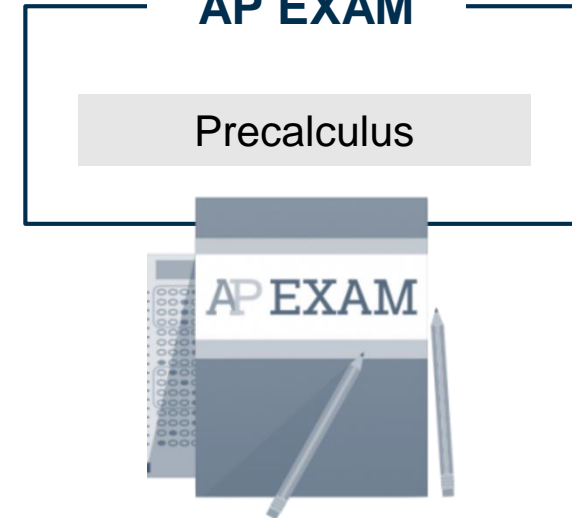
