Consider approval of Public Notice of Approval of Repeal of Board of Governors Regulation 6.012, Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 6.012, Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students, grants public secondary school students enrolled in articulated acceleration programs access to electronic library resources funded by the Florida Center for Library Automation.

Board staff propose repealing Regulation 6.012 and incorporating the content into Regulation 6.006, Acceleration Mechanisms, to better organize and streamline Board regulations by merging all accelerated mechanism requirements into a single regulation.

The Board of Governors approved the Public Notice of Intent to Repeal Board of Governors Regulation 6.012, Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students, at its June 22, 2023, meeting. Following approval of the public notice of intent, no public comments were received, and the repeal of the regulation is ready for final approval.
