Regulation 2.003 Equity & Access



Regulation 2.003



Purpose

Align equal access & opportunity for students, in employment, & in intercollegiate athletics with Florida Statutes





 Align with sections 110.112, 760.10, 1000.05, & 1006.71, Florida Statutes



- Changes the title of the regulation to "Equal Access & Opportunity"
- Includes nondiscrimination based on pregnancy
- Addresses equity & reporting for intercollegiate athletics



Reduces reporting burden

Regulation 8.014 Bachelors' Degree Exceptions to 120 Credit Hours Requirement



Regulation 8.014



Purpose

Establish processes for changes in hours to degree requirements





- Align with section 1007.25, Florida Statutes
- Increase efficiency in program actions



- Removes university authority to make incremental adjustments to the credit hour length of a bachelor degree program approved to exceed 120 credit hours
- Authorizes university board of trustees to approve a reduction in credit hours for programs approved to exceed 120 credit hours



- Must seek Board of Governors approval for any increase in baccalaureate program credit hours above 120
- Allows flexibility to reduce program hours back to 120 credit hours
