For millions of students, SAT scores can strengthen their college applications.

- In the class of 2022, nearly 1.3 million U.S. students had SAT scores that confirmed or exceeded their high school GPA.
- Among those, more than 400,000 were African American or Latino, nearly 350,000 were first-generation college goers, and nearly 250,000 were from small towns or rural communities.
- Recent studies have shown that test scores can be a key source of access for under-represented and first-generation students in the admissions process

More than 80% of students and parents want to be able to submit SAT scores

The SAT is transitioning to digital

- The digital SAT Suite will measure the same core college readiness knowledge and skills.
- SAT scores will mean the same thing, on the same scale.
- Tests will continue to be proctored in a school or test center.

Key Benefits for Students

- Students live digital lives and feel comfortable testing digitally.
- The SAT Suite is shorter about two hours instead of three, with shorter passages.
- Students and educators will receive scores faster – in days, not weeks.
- The digital SAT Suite is more secure and flexible to deliver. Each student gets a unique version of the test.

SAT Fee Waiver Benefits

 Schools no longer need to submit student-level fee-waiver requests for inschool testing. Discounts are given at the school level.

 Counselors still receive fee waiver codes to distribute to eligible students.

Starting this fall, students will also be able to directly request a fee waiver from College Board.





BigFuture Scholarships




11th and 12th graders can now earn entries for scholarship drawings by completing steps on their dashboard.






