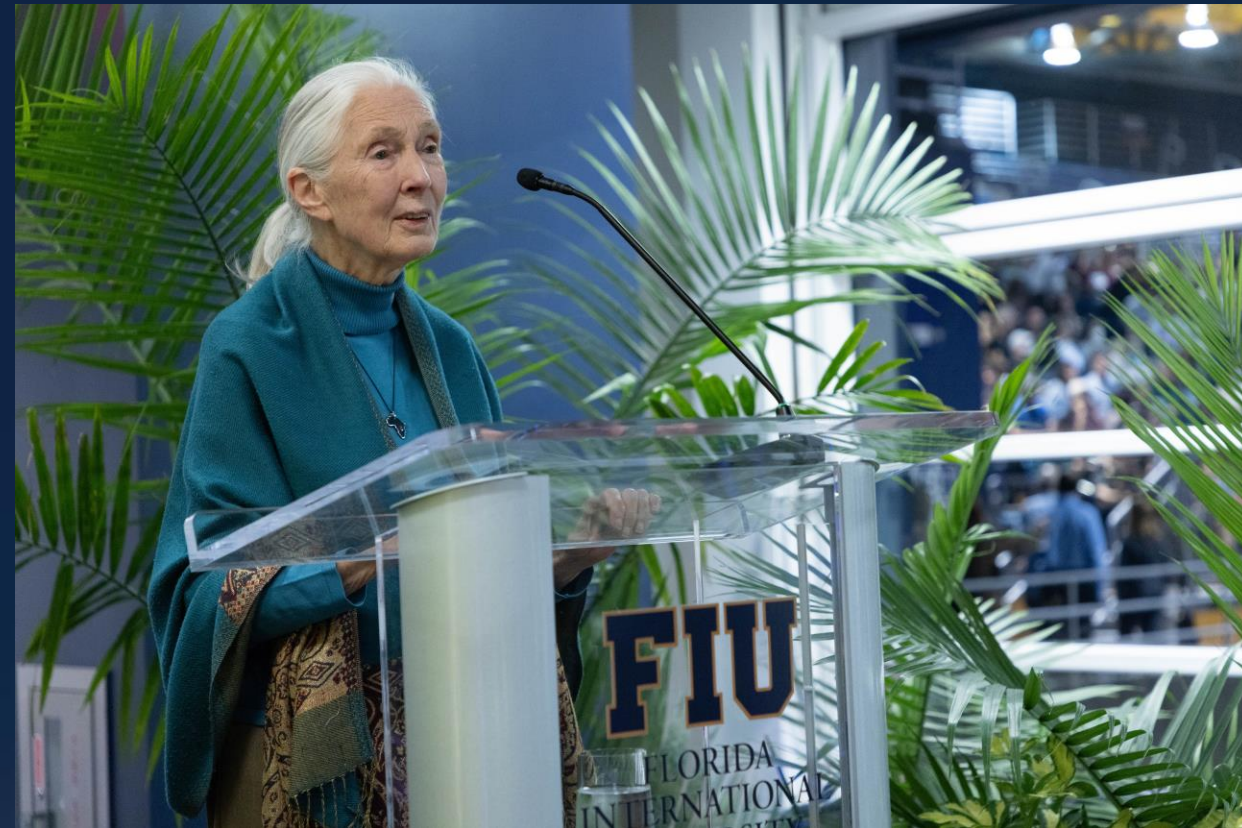

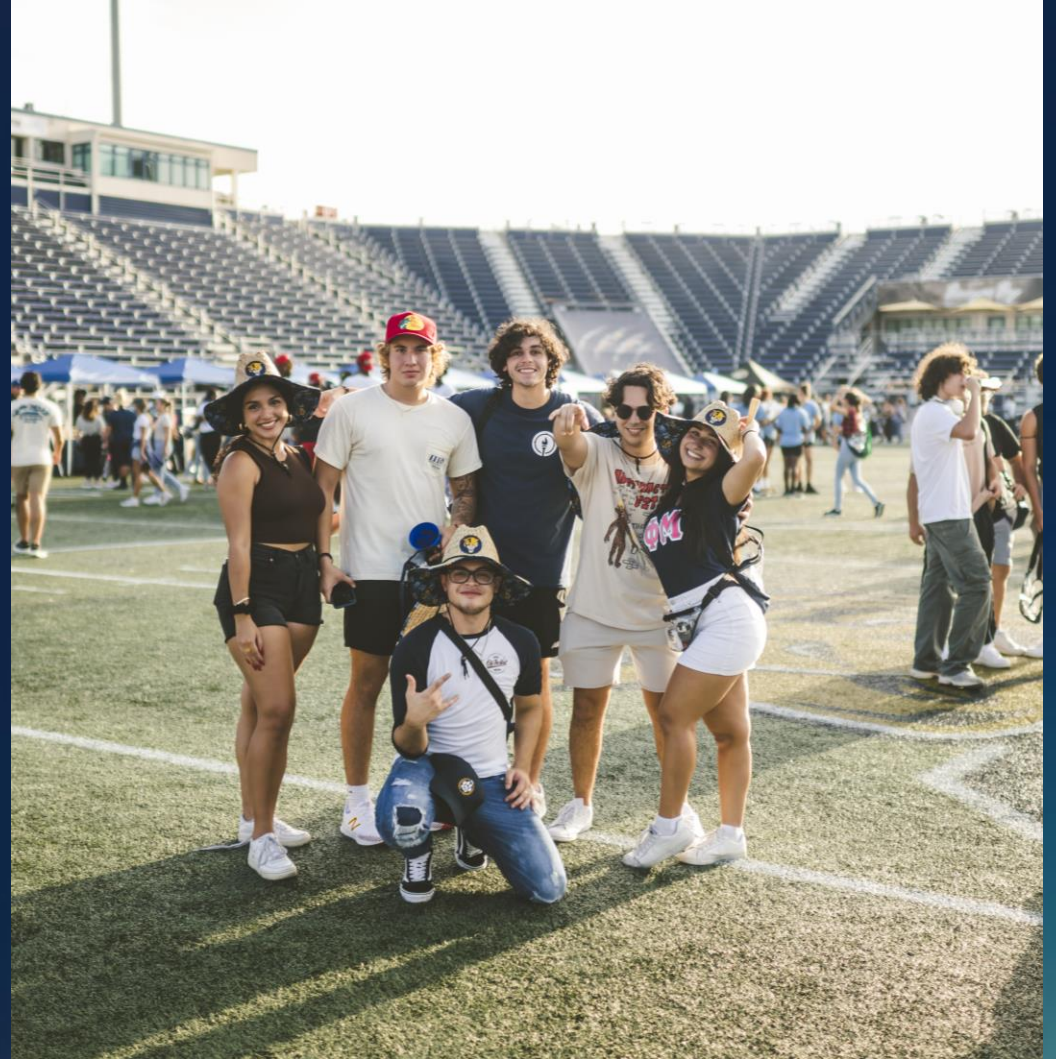

EARLY FALL	JUNE 17, 2024
FALL	AUGUST 26, 2024
ENGINEERING LAB, STEM STEP	STEM or Business Major who is not calculus ready
Admission Petition & Appeals Committee	Applicants who have been denied admission can submit additional information to support their appeal.
Deferred	This gives applicants the opportunity to submit first semester grades or a new test score. Deferred files will have a final review by March 25.
Pathway Placement Appeal	Only under extenuating circumstances with supporting documents.
Specialized Admission Major	Majors with limited space, clinical facilities, equipment, etc. and thereby require additional admission criteria such as GPA, entrance exam, portfolio or audition.
Supported Transition to Excellence (STEP)	Program designed to help ease a student through their first two semesters of college; financial aid and scholarships are adjusted.
