BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board Regulation 2.002, University Accountability Plans, requires the Board of Governors to annually submit a State University System Accountability Plan to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. At its June 2023 meeting, the Strategic Planning Committee considered approval of the 2023 accountability plans. In addition, the committee considered the annual university preeminence status updates for Florida State University, the University of Florida, the University of South Florida, and the emerging preeminence updates for Florida International University and the University of Central Florida. The committee will consider approval of a revised version of the 2023 New College of Florida Accountability Plan at this meeting.

Based on the data and information provided in the institutional accountability plans, Board staff analyzed system-level data and trends for key performance indicators. The System Accountability Plan also includes system information on academic program actions. If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee, the 2023 System Accountability Plan will be forwarded to the full Board for consideration.

Ms. Emily Sikes, Assistant Vice Chancellor for Strategic Initiatives and Economic Development, will present highlights of the 2023 System Accountability Plan.
