Support the efforts of state universities to recruit & retain exemplary faculty & research scholars


#### **PROGRAM GOALS**

- Over \$518 M in research proposals under development



### Professional Graduate Degree Excellence Program 2022-23 Expenditures




Most (87%) of the funds were used to recruit & retain faculty & support student success initiatives

Institutions reported **positive economic impacts** as a result of enhancing their graduate programs






