Current Regulation

- Outlines definitions, criteria, & process for new academic program approval
- Ensures that new programs are high quality & aligned with the Board of Governors' strategic plan

Need for the Amendment

University feedback for improving efficiency

- Required to include programs
 3 years out in university
 accountability plans
- Changes require re-approval of accountability plan

Pathway to approve academic programs with a longer implementation timeline

- No pathway for programs that require legislative requests & new facilities
- Example: FAU Dental

Reorganization of the approval process

- Steps were scattered in Regulations 8.011 & 8.004
- Process not clearly outlined in one place

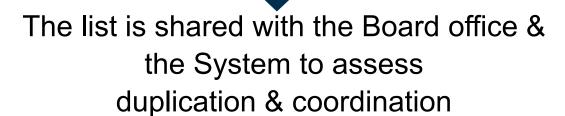
Current

Universities must include proposed programs for the next 3 years their accountability plans

 Any changes to the list requires re-approval of the accountability plan

Proposed Change

Boards of trustees review the list of proposed programs for the upcoming academic year



Universities can make changes to the list during the academic year



Increases efficiency & flexibility in proposing new academic programs to meet workforce demands

Proposed Change

Programs with Longer Implementation Timelines

 No process for universities to initiate programs from scratch (no existing resources or infrastructure)

- Outlines the process for new degree proposals that need additional time for implementation
- Allows the Board to require regular updates to monitor the progress on the conditions of approval



Allows a path for universities to develop new programs that need a longer implementation timeline

Reorganization

- 2 regulations include steps in the academic program approval process
- Steps in the process are not laid out in a logical order

- Consolidates Regulations 8.004 & 8.011
- Reorganizes & streamlines information to clearly identify the steps in the process
- Changes name to "Academic Degree Program Coordination & Approval"
