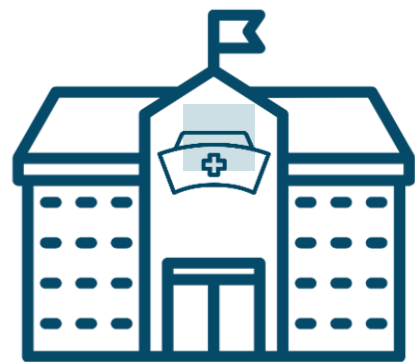

SUS Nursing Programs Continue to Increase Capacity



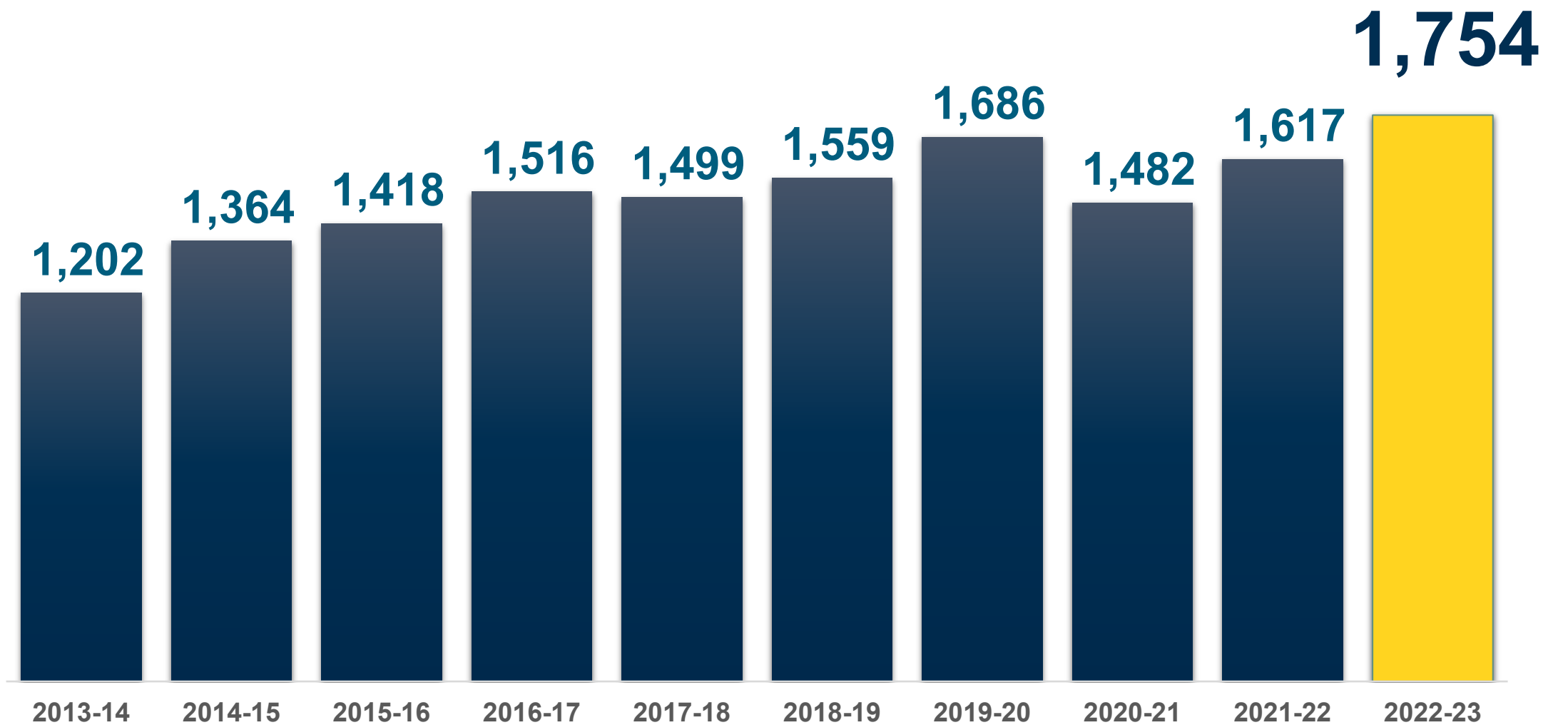

Nursing Graduate Employment Rates & Wages



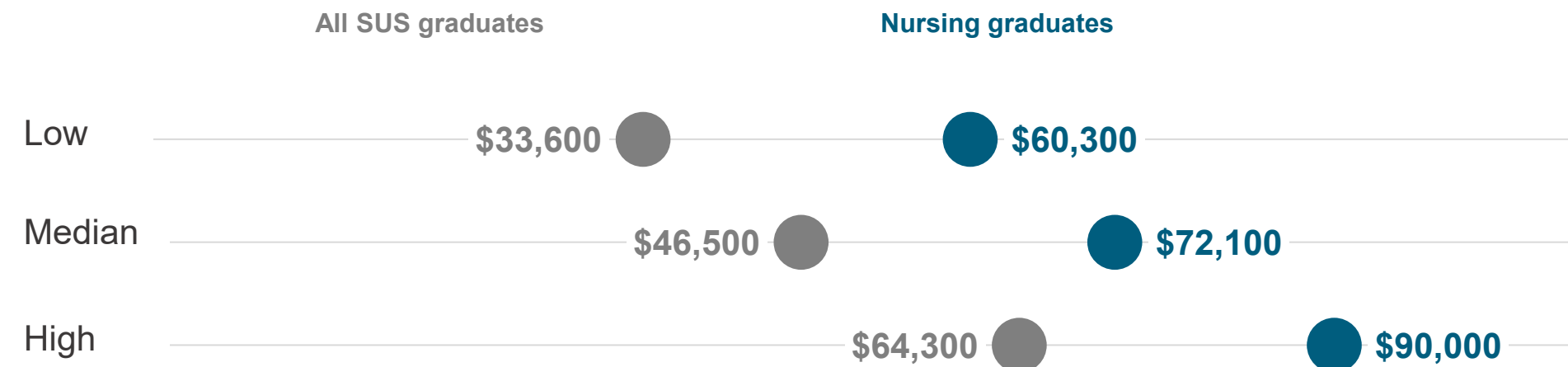
System graduates are employed at high rates & earn above average wages

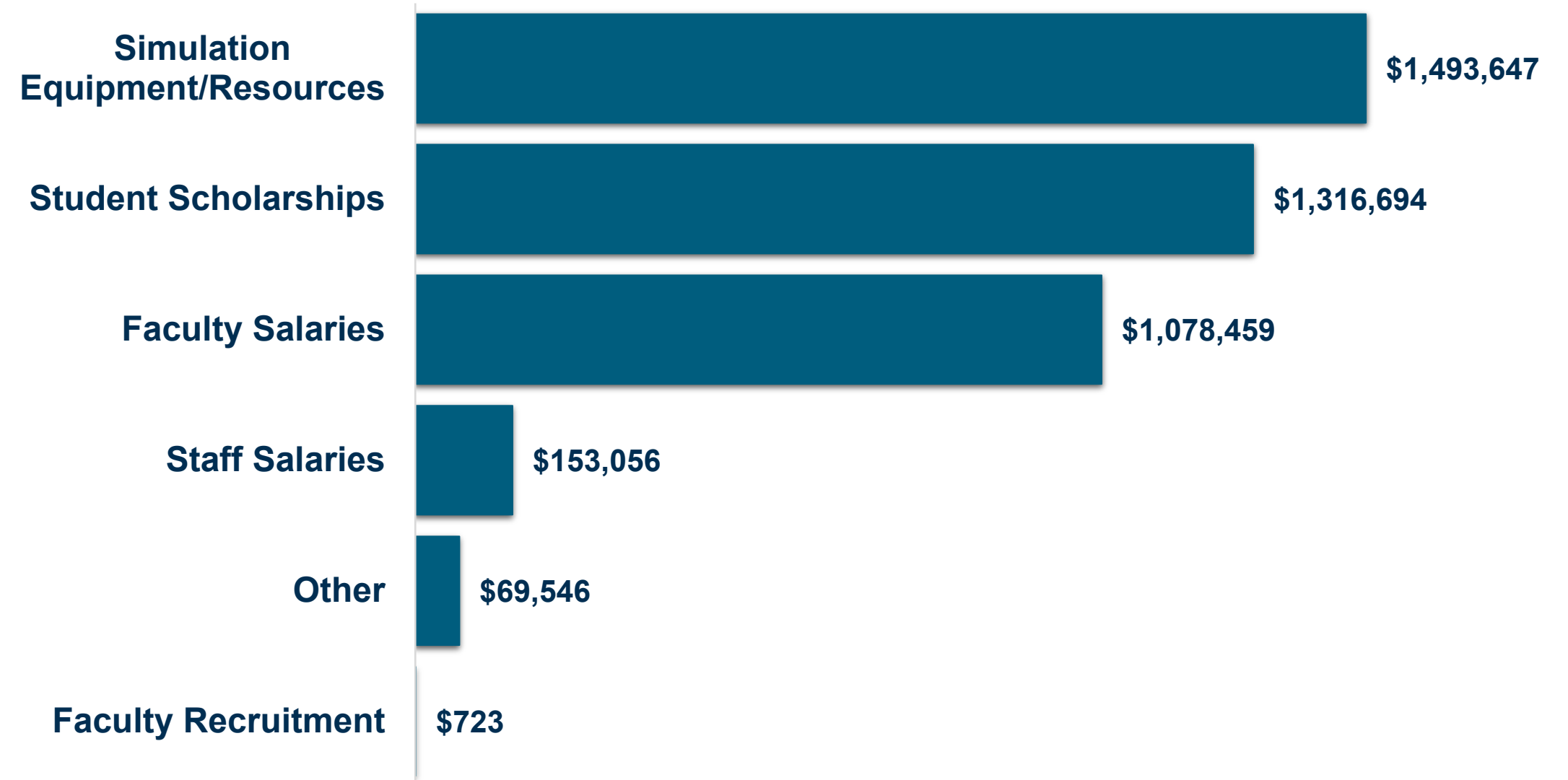
