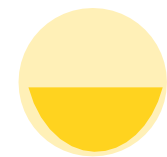

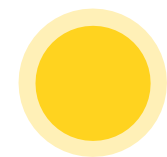

Impetus for Action

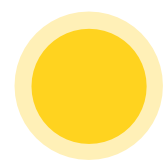
- New options approved to meet civic literacy requirements
