Consider approval of amendment of Board of Governors Regulation 6.001, General Admissions.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution, Section 1001.7415, Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 6.001, General Admissions, outlines requirements for the admission of students to State University System institutions.

During the 2023 session, the Florida Legislature passed House Bill 931, which was signed into law on May 15, 2023. The new law created section 1001.7415, Florida Statutes, prohibiting higher education institutions from requiring or soliciting a political loyalty test for employment, admission, or promotion. Board staff proposed an amendment to Regulation 6.001 to align with section 1001.7415 of the Florida Statutes.

The Board approved the public notice of intent to amend this regulation at the January 24, 2024, meeting. No public comments were received, and the regulation is ready for final approval.
