PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Repeal Board of Governors Regulation 8.004, Academic Program Coordination.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 8.004, Academic Program Coordination, outlines two specific components of academic program coordination. The first section outlines the role of the Council of Academic Vice Presidents (CAVP) and the CAVP Academic Coordinating Group (CAVP ACG) to ensure collaboration and coordination of academic programs across the State University System. The second section of the regulation outlines requirements for offering academic programs at education sites that are not part of the main campus or additional approved campuses.

Board staff propose repealing Regulation 8.004. The requirement for reviewing academic programs by CAVP and CAVP ACG has been incorporated into the proposed amendment to Regulation 8.011, Authorization of New Academic Degree Programs and Other Curricular Offerings, to better organize the steps in the program approval process. The proposed amendment to Regulation 8.011 is on the Board's agenda for final approval. Board staff is working to incorporate some of the provisions regarding education sites in an amendment to Regulation 8.009, Educational Sites. A proposed amendment to this regulation is anticipated to be ready for the June Board of Governors meeting.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the notice of intent to repeal will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the repeal of the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.
