BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1007.23(8), Florida Statutes, requires each state university to execute at least one 2+2 targeted pathway articulation agreement with one or more Florida College System institutions. The 2+2 targeted pathway articulation agreements facilitate a smooth transfer process for students seeking a bachelor's degree after completing an associate in arts degree. The intent of these agreements is to facilitate smooth articulation from the Florida College System to the State University System.

As part of the Board's Strategic Plan, SUS 30, the Board's goal is to set a new standard for 2+2 student graduation rates, including elevating successful 2+2 targeted pathway programs. To support this strategic area, the Board office requested information on the active 2+2 targeted pathway articulation agreements with the Florida College System institutions, including enrollments, the number of program graduates, and graduation rates.
