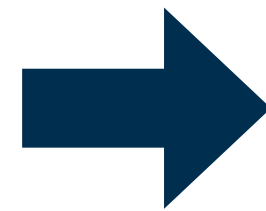

**2+2 Targeted Pathway with a Florida College**

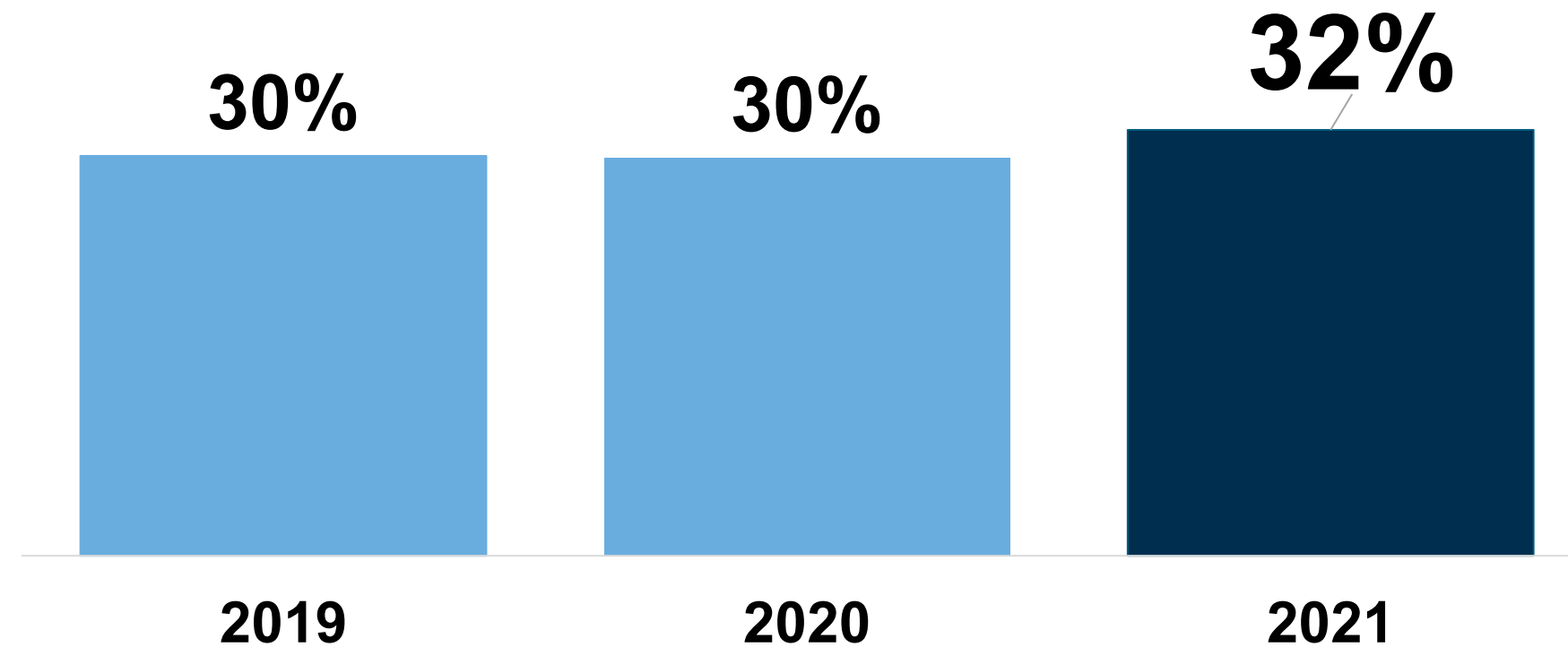

Over **5,700** students (**32%** of all entering 2+2 students) entered a **2+2 Targeted Pathway Program** in 2021 at a state university

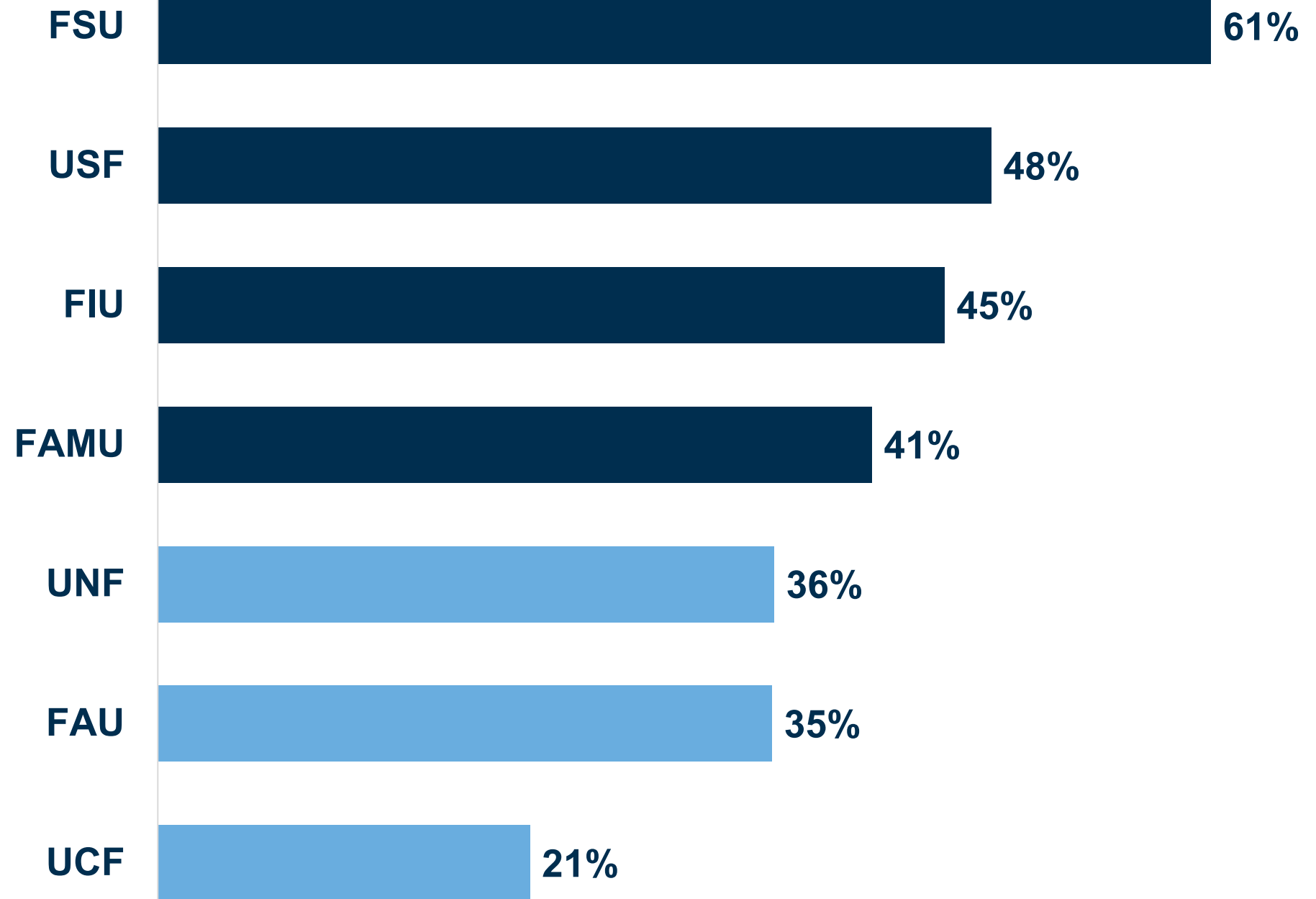


# 2-Year Graduation Rates

2 years**

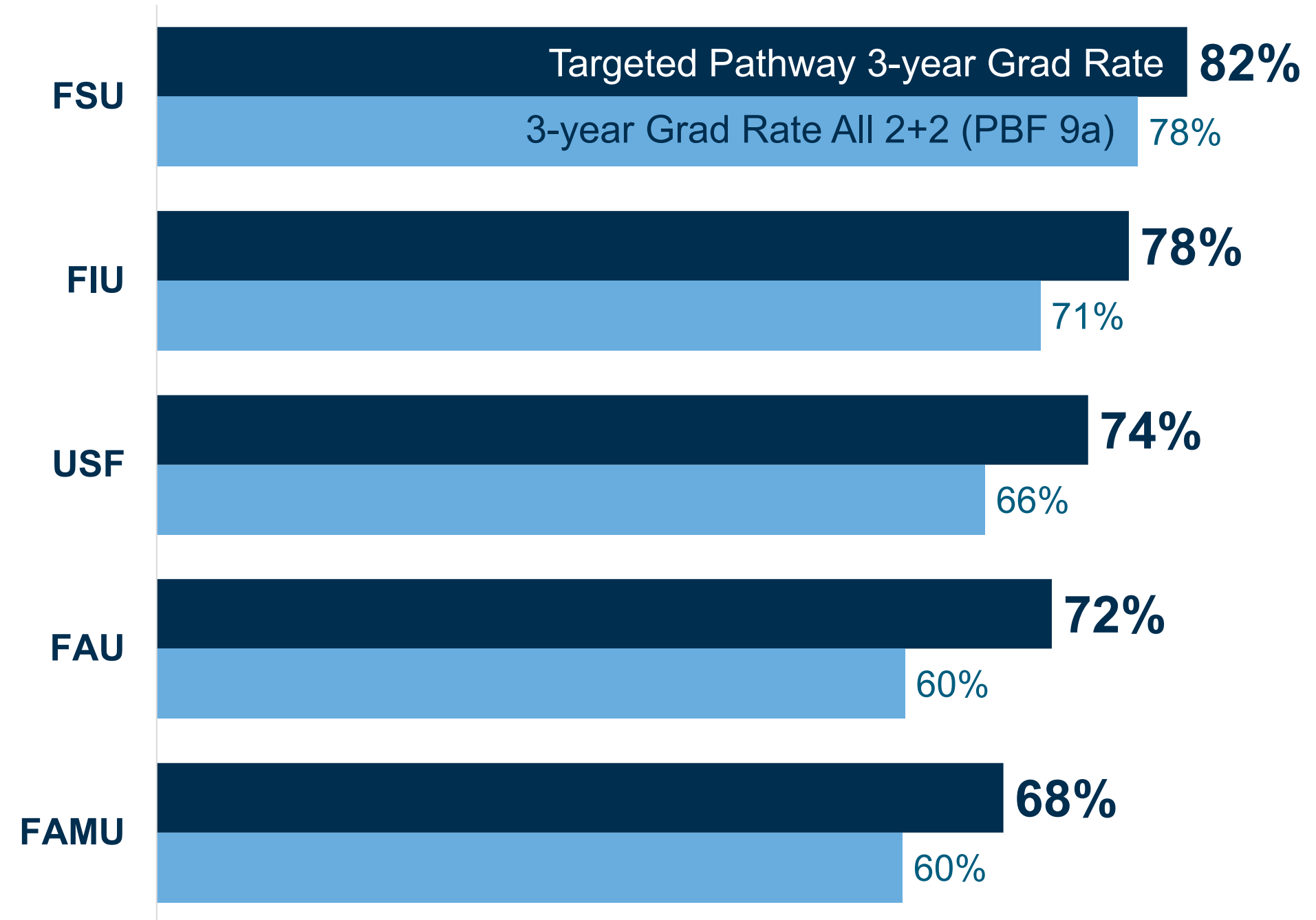


# 3-Year Graduation Rates
