PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 6.002, Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 6.002, Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen, establishes requirements for first-time-in-college (FTIC) students seeking admission to State University System institutions. Board staff propose amending Regulation 6.002 to clarify that universities cannot require part-time enrollment as a condition of FTIC admission. The amendment also provides a limit on the number of part-time new FTIC students that universities can enroll beginning in fall 2026.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the amended regulation will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.
