AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors regulation 7.007, Latin American and Caribbean Scholarship Eligibility, establishes requirements for certain scholarships offered to State University System students. Board staff propose repealing Regulation 7.007 to comply with federal law. The regulation is not required in Florida Statutes.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the repeal will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the repeal of the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Dr. Lynn Nelson, Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Innovation, will provide an overview of the proposed amendment.
