


UF Jacksonville

Campus Development Update

- Permanent site selected in the LaVilla neighborhood December 2024.
- Jacksonville City Council conveyed 20+ acres of land June 2025.
- This site includes an available building for launching initial academic programs in Fall 2026 and will be a permanent part of the campus.
- Renovations at the initial building will commence this fall and will complete in Summer 2026.

Campus Development Update


 UF recently issued ITN to procure a development team for design and construction of campus buildings.

1A

- Campus flagship building
- Forward thinking administrative, curricular, research, and services spaces
- Construction to commence early 2027
- Building complete by mid 2029

1B

- Research-focused facility
- To be constructed simultaneously or just after 1A



Future Academic Programs for New Building

- Existing programs in areas of excellence such as
 - Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist Program
 - Physician Assistant Studies
- New options in emerging fields
 - Interdisciplinary programming
 - Al and computer science
 - Health sciences
- Potential certificate programming as campus expands
- UF continuing to partner with Jacksonville institutions to explore high-impact collaboration opportunities, with Nursing emerging as a leading area of alignment
- UF continuing to support local institutions access to HiPerGator





National Security Research in Jacksonville

FSI is a UF-led statewide initiative focused on coordinating the State's semiconductor ecosystem, executing high impact R&D programs, and expanding the talent pipeline in the semiconductor industry.

Establishment of Advanced
Technology Center on
Jacksonville campus, colocating UF R&D programs with
the semiconductor industry

\$80M state appropriation for FSI in Jacksonville including \$45M for construction of the Advanced Technology Center and \$35M for operations

Potential site for UF's national security applied research efforts given proximity to military installations

Immediate impact on Jacksonville's economy and significant leveraging of funds

R&D focus on topics that complement UF Jacksonville academic offerings including engineering design and manufacturing, digital twins, and more

Currently in discussions with a finalist for an Assistant Vice President of National Security Research to lead FSI

Operational Update

- Admissions to open later this year for fall 2026 programming, in conjunction with the launch of campus-wide marketing campaigns.
- UF has initiated hiring efforts for initial administrative roles supporting central operations, recruitment, corporate engagement, and IT infrastructure.
- UF has begun searches for programmatic faculty and staff to support initial academic programs.
