Textbook & Instructional Materials Affordability & Transparency



Purpose

Establishes
transparency &
affordability policies
for course materials



Impetus for Action

- Provide greater transparency for students to make informed decisions



Summary of Changes

- Adds the ability to search the list of materials by general education status
- Requires the posting of current syllabi for all courses & course sections
- Outlines the components to be included in course syllabi



Impact on Institutions

- Expands the requirement for posting current syllabi to all courses

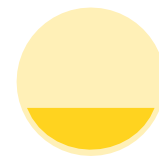
Regulation 6.002

Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen



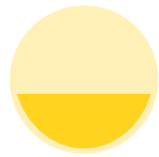
Purpose

Establishes admission requirements for first-time-in-college students



Impetus for Action

- Clearly specify enrollment requirements of part-time students as a condition of admission



Summary of Changes

- Prohibits part-time enrollment as a condition of admission
- Establishes a cap on part-time new first-time-in-college enrollment
- Allows universities to request an exception to the cap



Impact on Institutions

- Limits part-time new first-time-in-college enrollment to 5%

Regulation 7.005

Determination of Residency Status for Tuition Purposes



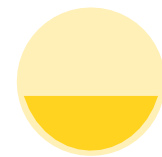
Purpose

Defines the requirements for a student to be classified as a Florida resident for tuition purposes



Impetus for Action

- Clean up regulation & ensure alignment with Florida Statutes & Florida College System



Summary of Changes

- Creates definitions for classifications & terms associated with residency
- Clarifies reclassification eligibility & process
- Sets minimum requirements for university regulations related to residency



Impact on Institutions

- Requires development & adoption of university regulations & policies for residency status

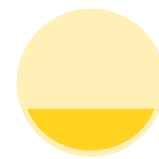

General Admissions



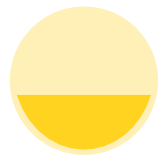
Purpose

Outlines admission requirements for students & university policies & procedures



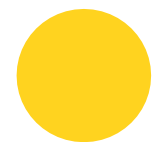
Impetus for Action

- Increase transparency of admission requirements



Summary of Changes

- Specifies the posting criteria for admission requirements
- Includes specialized & programmatic admission requirements



Impact on Institutions

- Publish admission requirements on the university website & in the catalog

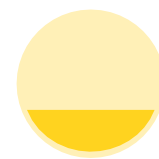
Regulation 7.007

Latin American & Caribbean Scholarship Eligibility



Purpose

Establishes eligibility for awarding the Latin American & Caribbean Scholarship



Impetus for Action

- Ensure compliance with federal laws
