# **Exceptions to 120**Credit Hours



✓ Allows an institution to request a bachelor's degree program to exceed 120 credit hours to degree

### **Qualifying Criteria**

Additional courses required for accreditation standards

Additional courses required for professional licensing

Degree program offers a unique & innovative learning experience

### January 2024: Review of 120+ Credit Hour Programs



#### 2024

- programs with 120 credit exceptions
- 95 approved prior to 2015
- 3 approved between 2015-2020
