State University System Foreign Countries of Concern Report July 2024 – June 2025

Section 288.860, Florida Statutes, and Board of Governors Regulation 9.012, Foreign Influence, establish requirements regarding collaborations between Florida's public universities and foreign principals based in a foreign country of concern. The law and regulation require each institution's board of trustees in the State University System to submit an annual report to the Chancellor of the State University System of all agreements, partnerships, and contracts between the state university and foreign principals based in a foreign country of concern. Each institution's report must address the following components.

- All instances of identified grant programs, agreements, partnerships, and contracts between the university and any foreign principal in a country of concern, and the expected expiration or termination date.
- Any office, campus, or physical location used or maintained by the university in a foreign country of concern or with a foreign principal.

For the period of this report, July 2024 through June 2025, four universities (Florida State University, the University of Florida, the University of South Florida, and the University of West Florida) reported 25 agreements, partnerships, or contracts with foreign countries of concern. Fourteen of the 25 reported agreements for this period were not included in the previous year's report but were identified by institutions following the approval of the 2023-24 report in November 2024.

Of the 25 reported agreements, 14 expired, 8 were terminated, and 3 were still active in November 2025. The three active agreements are at the University of Florida and were reported in the prior year's report. These agreements are set to expire between 2029 and 2035. Two of these agreements are licensing agreements in which a company pays the University of Florida to use technology developed by researchers at the university. One agreement is for University of Florida researchers to use a material from a country of concern. All reported agreements, partnerships, or contracts were based in China. The three active agreements are a reduction from the 16 reported in the 2023-2024 report.

Table 1 summarizes the institutions' grant programs, agreements, partnerships, and contracts. Table 2 provides a year-over-year comparison of reported active agreements, partnerships, or contracts with countries of concern between the previous and current annual reports. Appendix A includes the master list of agreements, partnerships, or contracts with foreign countries of concern reported during the 2024-25 Fiscal Year.

¹FSU reported three expired contracts for the testing and performance evaluation of materials used in medical and engineering research. FSU reported two expired contracts for books and news subscriptions added to the university's library resources.

²UF reported two expired agreements for medical research resources. UF reported eight terminated agreements, contracts, and partnerships that included licensing agreements, material transfers, academic services, and memoranda of understanding regarding research cooperation.

³USF reported six expired contracts, all one-time purchases, for lab equipment not related to collaborative research with a foreign country of concern. The materials purchased included a stackable shaker incubator, a three-roll mill & transformer, tube furnaces, manual X-Axis and manual XY-Axis stages, and peptides intended exclusively for use by USF.

⁴UWF reported one contract for a one-time purchase with a warranty expiring on April 1, 2026. The purchase was for a robot designed by Unitree to be used by the Florida Institute for Human & Machine Cognition.

The two active contracts are for license revenue, where a company in China utilizes UF technology or intellectual property and makes payments to UF. The active contracts are set to expire in 2030 and 2034. The active agreement permits UF to use an imported biological substance for research purposes until 2035.
