Consider approval of Public Notice of Approval of Amendment to Board of Governors Regulation 6.002, Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 6.002, Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen, establishes requirements for first-time-in-college (FTIC) students seeking admission to State University System institutions. Board staff propose amending Regulation 6.002 to clarify that universities cannot require part-time enrollment as a condition of FTIC admission. The amendment also provides a limit on the number of part-time new FTIC students that universities can enroll beginning in fall 2026.

The Board approved the public notice of intent to amend this regulation on September 11, 2025. The amended regulation was available for public comment, and no public comments were received. The amended regulation is ready for final approval.
