PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 10.015, Institutes and Centers.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 10.015, Institutes and Centers, defines different types of institutes and centers. The regulation also outlines the requirements for establishing, disbanding, reviewing, and evaluating the effectiveness of institutes and centers.

Board staff propose a technical amendment to this regulation, eliminating the requirement for institutions to maintain their own inventory and reverting the responsibility for maintaining the official inventory to the Board of Governors' office.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the amended regulation will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during this time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Dr. Lynn Nelson, Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Innovation, will provide an overview of the proposed amendment.
