Be it resolved by the Senate of the University of South Florida Student Government assembled.

Whereas, the University of South Florida (USF) continues to advance its mission as a preeminent research institution dedicated to student success, innovation, and community engagement; and

**Whereas**, the Fletcher District project plans to redevelop **27 acres of the former Claw golf course** within a 138-acre parcel, expanding USF's footprint for mixed-use development north of Fletcher Avenue and East of North 46th Street; and

**Whereas**, the Fletcher District development project represents a transformative opportunity to address the university's growing demand for **on-campus housing**, directly supporting affordability, accessibility, and student retention; and

Whereas, the project will include USF-developed state-of-the-art academic and research facilities that strengthen USF's position as a leader in innovation; and

**Whereas**, this development embodies a **public–private partnership (P3)** model, meaning USF will not bear financial responsibility nor leverage its credit to finance the non-USF developed assets of the project, a win-win outcome benefiting both the university and students; and

**Whereas**, the Fletcher District project will serve as a living laboratory by providing **experiential learning and professional development opportunities**, benefiting the students in various academic disciplines; and
