BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1007.23, Florida Statutes, requires the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education, through a statewide articulation agreement, to preserve Florida's 2+2 system of articulation and facilitate the seamless articulation of student credits from the Florida College System to the State University System.

The ASPIRE TSC2FSU program, facilitated by Tallahassee State College (TSC) and Florida State University (FSU), exemplifies a well-designed 2+2 articulation pathway by aligning institutional collaboration, student-focused advising strategies, and transparent academic mapping. Florida State University has one of the highest three-year graduation rates for Florida College System AA transfers, at 82%, and the highest two-year graduation rate for students in a pathway program, at 61%.

Florida State University and Tallahassee State College will jointly present highlights of their pathway program and how they have collaborated to address challenges to ensure student success.
