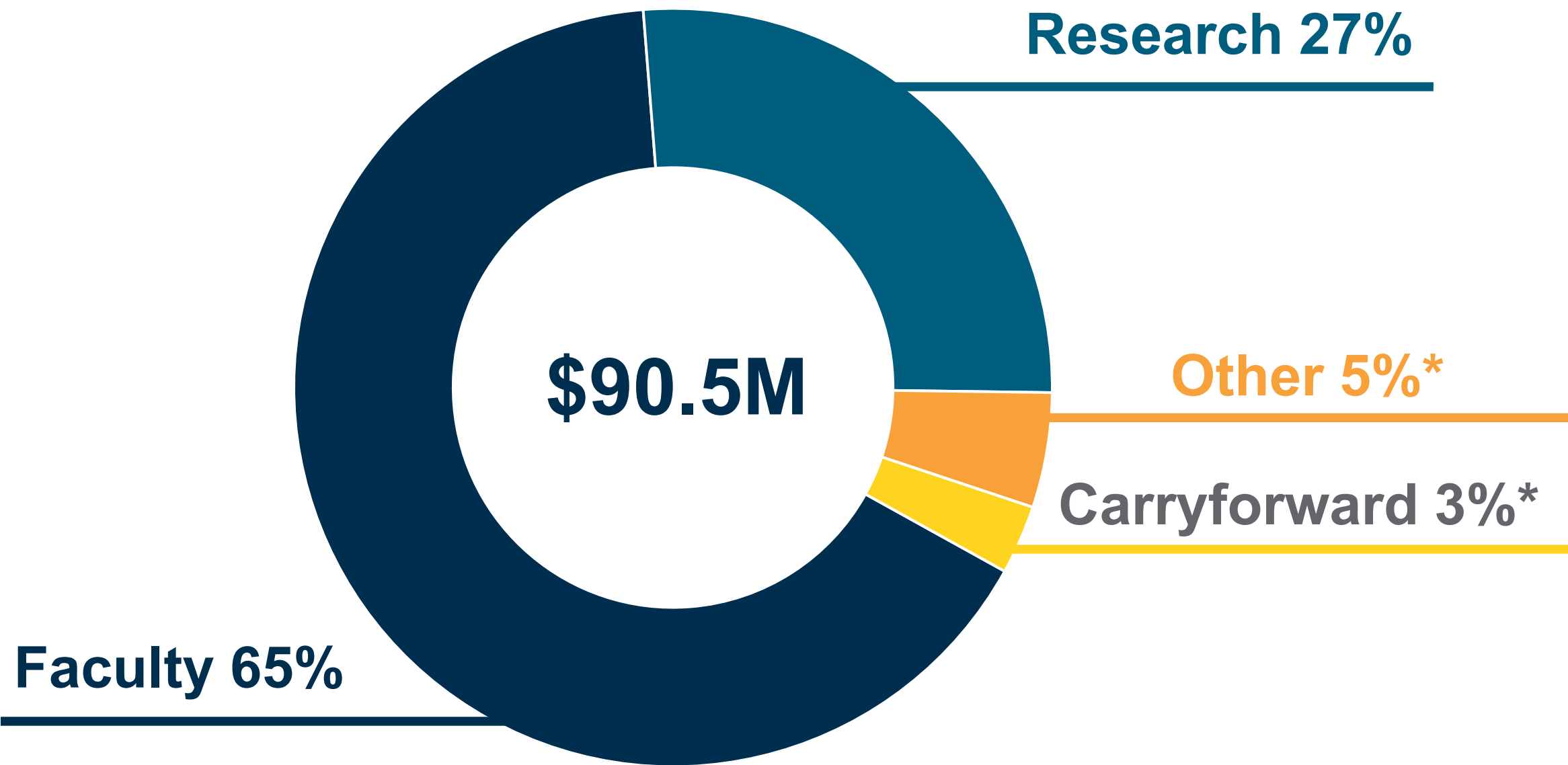
### PROGRAM GOALS

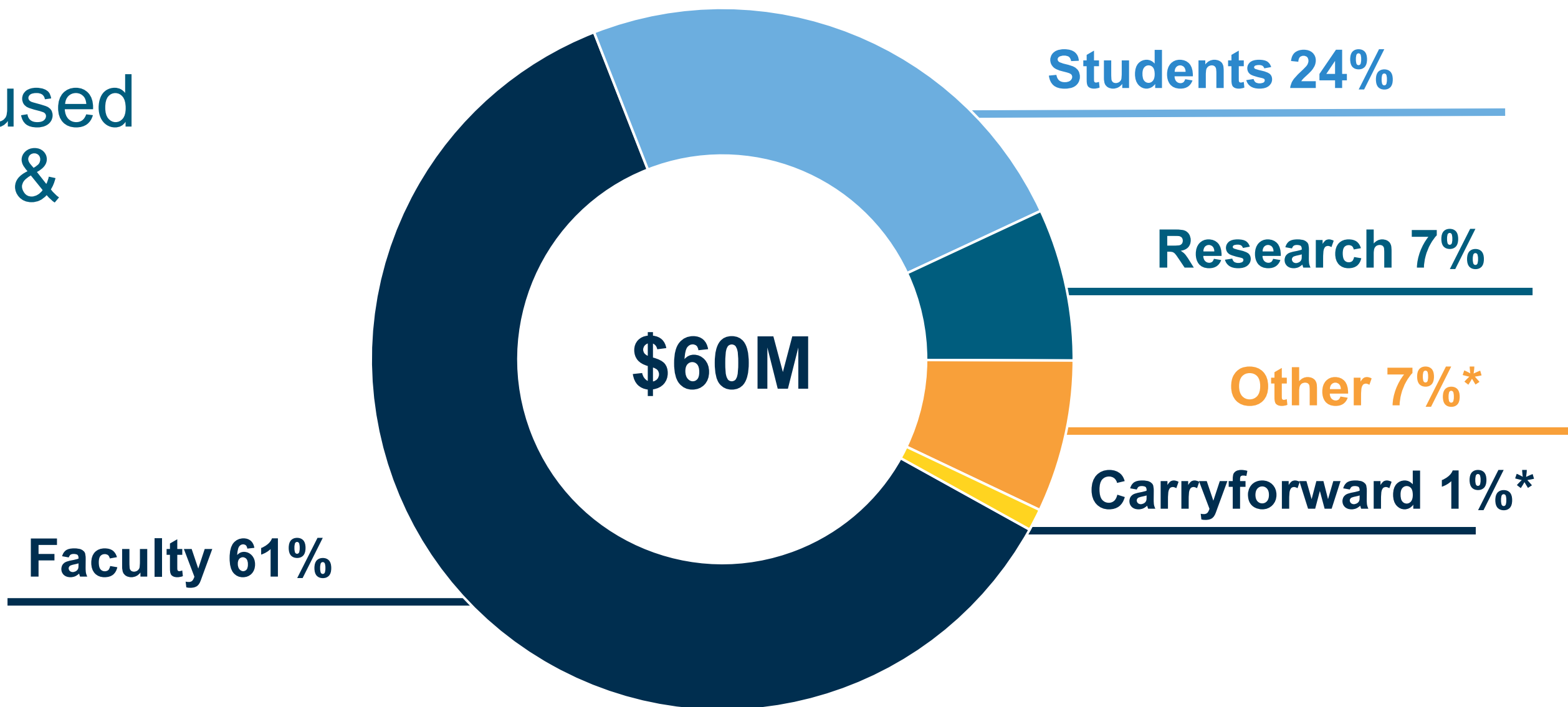

# Professional Graduate Degree Excellence Program 2024-25 Expenditures

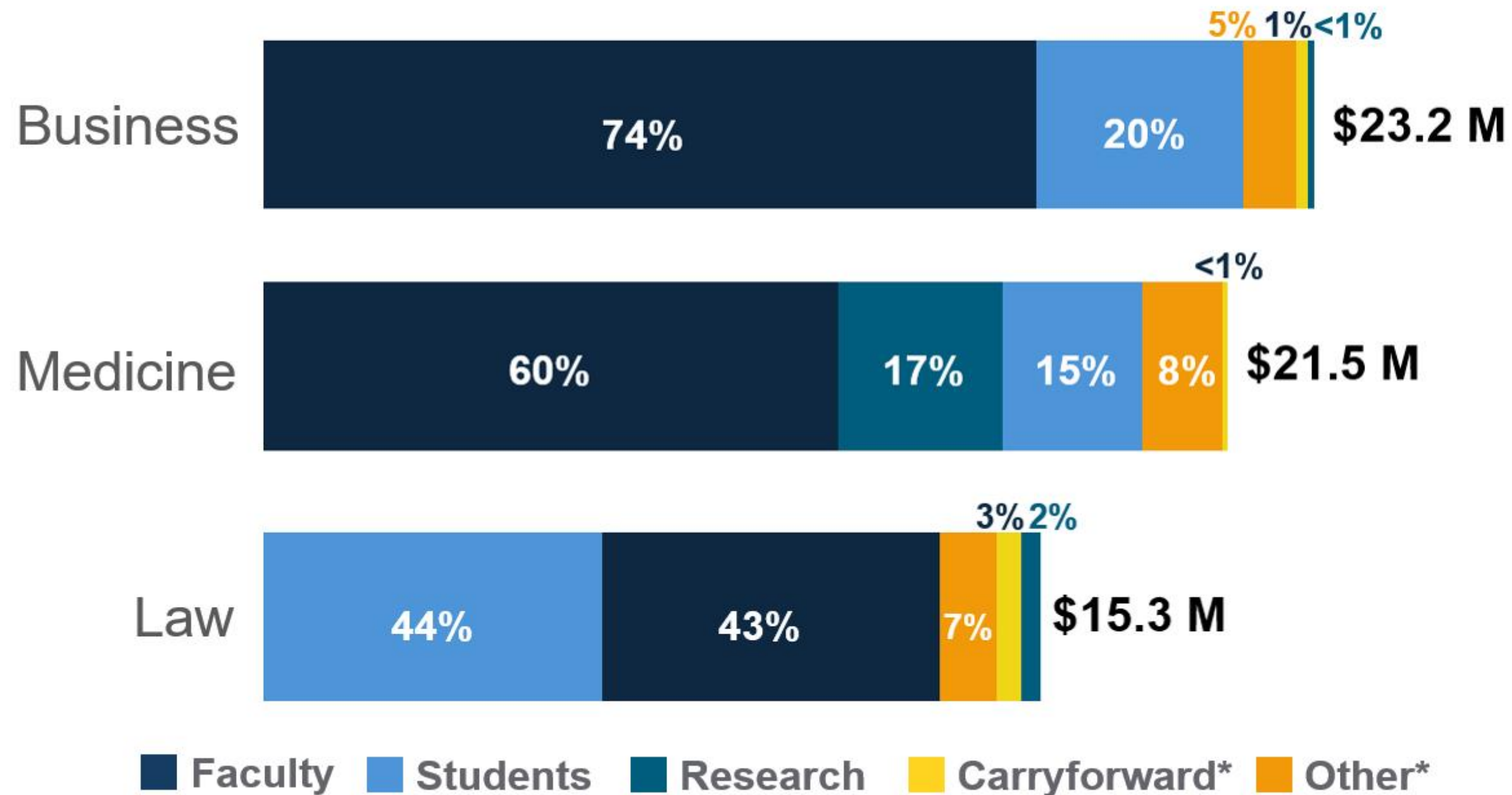


**85% of funding used
