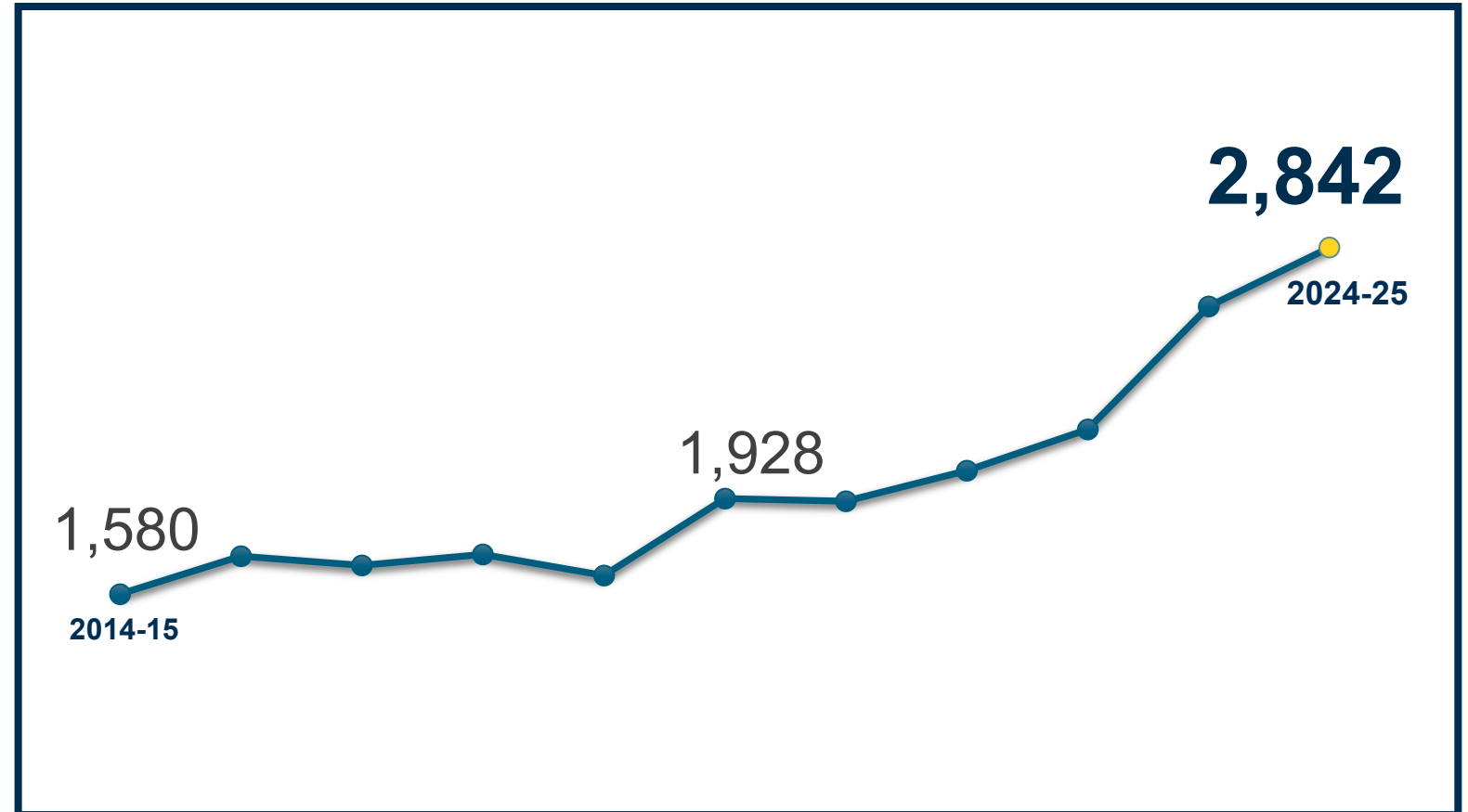

past 10 years

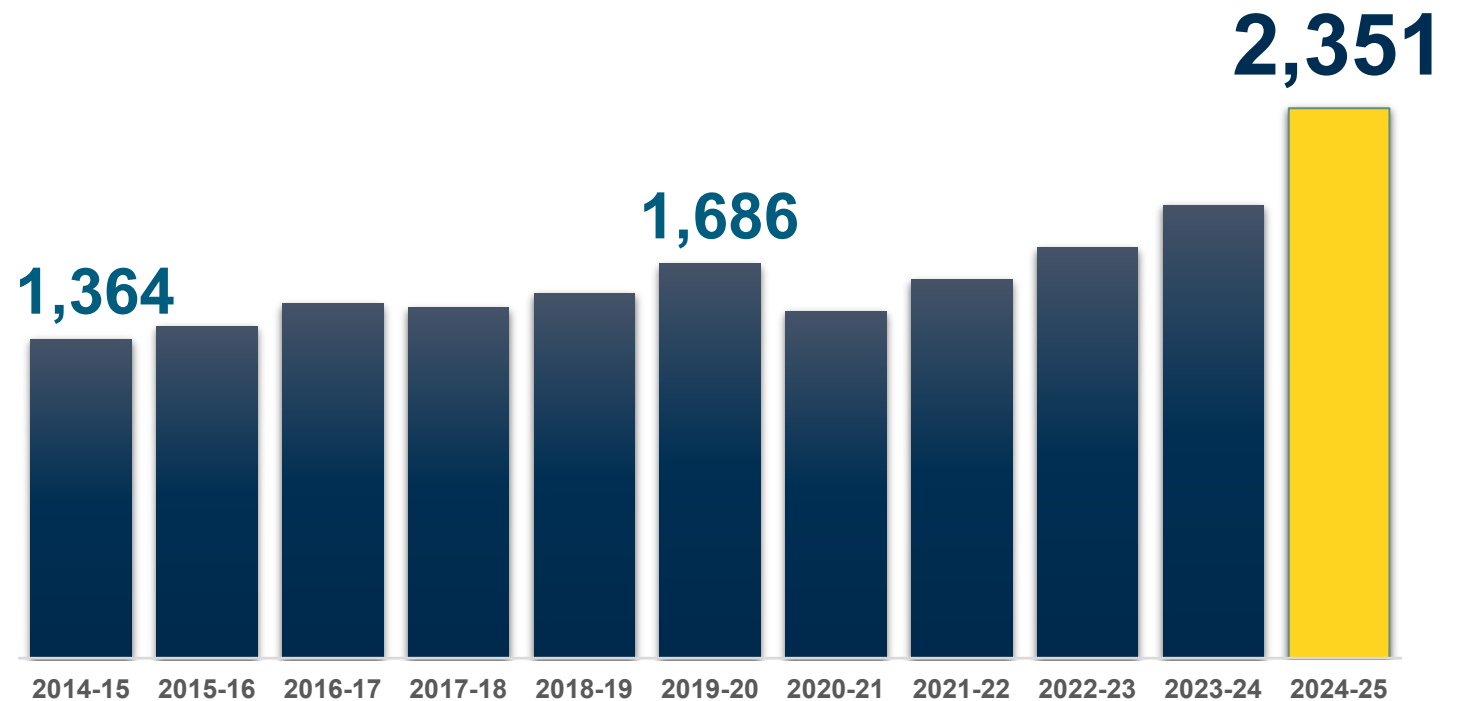

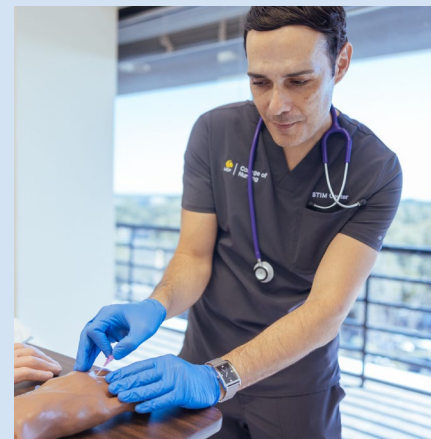
