Common Prerequisites

Lower-division courses required for admission to specific majors & programs

Statutory Requirements

S. 1007.25(7), F.S.

Identify **common prerequisite courses** that must be **offered & accepted statewide** & maintain a database for students

Purpose

Facilitates transfer & efficient progression to degree completion

Common Prerequisite Manual



Challenges

- Manual not maintained or updated
- Prerequisites have not been reviewed to ensure they support student success
- Alternative courses & tracks have been added over the years



Solution

Staff Review of Prerequisites



Goals

- Compliance with Florida Statutes
- Students & parents understand all requirements for programs
- The database is accurate
- The number of prerequisites should not exceed 8 courses (24 credit hours)
- Prerequisites are **common** across the same program
- Courses should be lower division & include general education when possible
