**SUBJECT:** Out-of-State Fee Increase

**PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION**

Consider approval of New College of Florida and Florida Polytechnic University's increase to the out-of-state fee.

**AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Section 1009.24(4)(b), Florida Statute; Board Regulation 7.001

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Section, 1009.24(b), Florida Statutes, requires the sum of tuition and out-of-state fees assessed to nonresident students to be sufficient to offset the full instructional cost of serving such students. New College of Florida and Florida Polytechnic University need to increase their out-of-state fee in an effort to come into compliance with the law. According to statute, adjustments to out-of-state fees or tuition for graduate programs and professional programs may not exceed 15 percent in any year.

On December 17, 2026, the New College of Florida Board of Trustees approved a 15% increase to the out-of-state fee going into effect with the Fall 2026 semester.

On May 22, 2026, the Florida Polytechnic University Board of Trustees approved a 15% increase to the out-of-state fee going into effect with the Fall 2026 semester.
