**SUBJECT:** Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors' Regulation 1.001, University Board of Trustees Power and Duties

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**PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION**

Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors' Regulation 1.001, University Board of Trustees Power and Duties.

**AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Board of Governors' Regulation 1.001, University Board of Trustees Powers and Duties, establishes the composition, organization, and authority of a university board of trustees and requires each university board of trustees to establish a personnel program for all employees of the university, including the president.

Board staff propose an amendment to Regulation 1.001 to address multiple issues. First, the proposed amendment clarifies post-service restrictions for members of the board of trustees. Second, the proposed amendment requires university boards of trustees to adopt policies that maintain institutional neutrality when addressing contentious political and social issues. Third, the proposed amendment requires university boards of trustees to establish policies requiring all course syllabi to include a disclosure of faculty use and permitted student use of artificial intelligence.

If approved by the Academic Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the amended regulation will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during this time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Ms. Emily Sikes, Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, will provide an overview of the proposed amendment.
