Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors' Regulation 2.002, University Accountability Plans.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution; Section 1001.706, Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors' Regulation 2.002, University Accountability Plans, outlines requirements for university planning and performance monitoring that include submissions of annual accountability plans designed to inform strategic planning, budgeting, and other policy decisions for the State University System.

Board staff propose an amendment to align the regulation with the changes proposed by House Bill 5061 during the Special Legislative Session E. The proposed amendment requires universities to provide their projected out-of-state enrollment percentages for nonresident, degree-seeking students pursuant to Regulation 7.006 for upcoming academic years. The amendment also makes technical edits to align Regulation 2.002 with Regulation 8.011.

If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee and the Board of Governors, the amended regulation will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during this time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Ms. Emily Sikes, Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, will provide an overview of the proposed amendment.
